This workshop is FREE and will be held at First Unitarian Church in Dallas, Preston & Normandy. <u>SAFE CONVERSATIONS</u> is a model for dialogue developed by Dallas based psychologists Dr. Harville Hendrix and Dr. Ruth Hunt. This training will teach the model and be the first event focused on having safe conversations about issues of race and racial justice. The model was developed and widely used in couples counseling to help people develop relational competencies and establish trust.
