What Did We Do in RE This Week? The worship theme this month is Transformation. *Preschool: Me and My Shadow. Ask your child:* Shadows move but they are not alive. What are some other things that move but are not alive? *Spirit Play K-1: The Rooster Who Learned to Crow. Ask your child:* How can you be a good friend when one of your friends is trying to learn something new? *Spirit Play 2-3: Stellanuna or The Blessing Seed. Ask your child:* What does it mean to be the same as someone else? What does it mean to be different? What are some important ways that we are all the same? What are some important ways that we are different? *Upper Elementary/Middle School 4-7: The Life of Jesus, the Power of Persistence. Ask your child:* This month's theme is transformation. Do you think that you can have transformation without persistence? What are some examples of changes that could not have happened without time and persistence? *OWL 8-9: Contraception.* Does having contraception available affect a person's life? How? Do you think having contraception available for women starting in the 1960s transformed the way women were able to be in the world? How? *High School 10-12: Art as a Transformative Spiritual Practice. Ask your teen:* What are some of the ways that doing art changes you? (Even just a little bit, even just for a moment.)
