**What's Happening in RE This Week? Jedi Academy (PreK through 8<sup>th</sup>):** Lesson Four – Yellow Principle (Learning Together). Today we played with “energy balls” and trust falls. *Ask your child: (all ages) What can you name that you cannot see but you know is real? (for elementary school, add) In what ways do you trust your friends to support you? (for middle schoolers, add) Why is it important to be able to trust your friends? What makes trust a spiritual practice?* **Social Justice Summer for Teens:** Pool Noodle Rockets. *Ask your teen: Which is more aligned with our UU principles, competition or collaboration? Why do you think so?*

**Soul Work.** The tables at the side of the sanctuary are Soul Work: activities for all ages that engage the hands while allowing the brain and heart to connect with the worship service.
