What's Happening in RE This Week? Jedi Academy (PreK through 8th): Lesson Five – Green Principle (Search for Truth and Meaning – Grow Together by Asking Questions!). Today we learned about religious symbols and personal symbols. *Ask your child: (all ages) What is the symbol for our church? (for elementary school, add) What did you learn about symbols for other religions? (for middle schoolers, add) Why do you think people use or need symbols?* **Social Justice Summer for Teens:** We began exploring the history of the Holocaust and how it affects us today. *Ask your teen:* How is what you learned today different from what you've learned at school? How is it similar?
