Directions from Community UU Church to Oak Point Park and Nature Preserve

- From the church building, go West on E. Parker Rd.
- Turn RIGHT on Jupiter Rd.
 - pass Collin College, Oak Point Center, go through the intersection at Spring Creek Parkway.
- Pass over the bridge and you will see the sign for Los Rios Blvd - there is no stop light here. There are 2 green signs for the Oak Point Nature Preserve and McCall Elementary.
- Turn RIGHT onto Los Rios Blvd.
- The road will curve - you will see the entrance for Oak Point Nature Preserve on the RIGHT.
- Follow the driveway into the park - it will end in a large circular parking lot.
- Park near the far south end of the lot. The Pavilion is on the path to the left of the restrooms.

Comfort and planning notes:

The service will take place as planned "rain or shine". Please dress accordingly as we will be outside the entire time. The Pavilion provides shelter from rain and some wind.

The park seating in the Pavilion is metal picnic tables. **If you anticipate needing other seating to enjoy the service (such as padded cushions for the benches or camping chairs), please plan ahead.**
